### *Harry Potter and the Cursed Child to open on Broadway in April 2018*

The show, which is set 19 years after Harry Potter and the Deathly Hallows, has been playing to record crowds in London's West End. The US production will open at the Lyric theatre, which is currently undergoing a redesign in preparation for the show's North American premiere. Cirque de Soleil Paramour is currently showing there. Harry Potter and the Cursed Child is based on a story by JK Rowling and written by the Bafta-winning screenwriter and dramatist Jack Thorne. Last month, the production took home a record-breaking nine Olivier awards, including best new play. Reviews have been largely positive, with the Guardian's Michael Billington calling it "dazzling".

Tickets will go on sale this fall and it will go up against Disney's Frozen musical, which is also slated to hit Broadway in spring 2018.

Danet Rios lost basically everything in the Memorial Day weekend floods. Five months later, repairs were finally coming together. Then on Halloween, a flood just six inches lower than the last devastated her home again. It was the same damage. The family of five lost their home, clothes, computers, and more. ADRN helped Rios and her family find a hotel. Space was 9 \_\_\_\_\_—Rios' two daughters shared the bedroom, her son slept on the couch, and she and her husband slept on a mattress in the kitchen. 10 \_\_\_\_\_, after six months, ADRN bought the family a double-wide mobile home.
